The Virginia Chapter of the Association for Learning Environments Annual Conference will be held at the Williamsburg Lodge in Williamsburg, Virginia, on April 16-17, 2018. This year, the Virginia Chapter will offer two nights' accommodations at the Williamsburg Lodge for up to 100 school division representatives. A jury will judge the completed projects and awards will be presented to the architects and winning schools. Keynote and major session speakers will present information on a number of critical educational and facilities issues. There will also be breakout sessions on various subjects of interest to facilities and maintenance personnel, including school design presentations by college level architecture students.
