# Future Job Opportunity: Athletic Trainer

Athletic trainers can be defined as a certified health care professional who cares for sports athletes and practices sports medicine. These types of doctors do examinations, diagnosis, and certain treatments for injured athletes. Athletic trainers are used for the care of not just athletes but anyone that needs the treatment. For this specific job, someone must have a college degree from any college, but more likely to be the division one colleges that have the best education. The salary for getting a job as a athletic trainer is between \$40,869 and \$50,371 per year (BLS). The benefits of being an athletic trainer is the company pays for holidays and vacations, provides health insurance, and guarantees retirement benefits. Not every person qualifies to be an athletic trainer, but they will have some type of specific job title. These specific titles depend on degrees, experience, and education (BLS).

In order to be an athletic trainer, people need to know a large range of medical problems or symptoms, to be able to note the state of a patient, and to follow procedures to keep the athlete from harming himself/herself (BLS). Another thing the trainer would need to be good at is they would have to be able to think quickly. Quick thinking allows them the ability to help athletes to play again at their previous ability level. Paying attention to the smallest details benefits trainers. How most athletes are is they want to stay in the competition because they love that sport. But it's an athletic trainer's job to look for those tiny hints in an athlete's performance that hint toward a career-ending problem. Correcting that problem is the responsibility of the trainer.

According to the <u>Occupational Outlook Handbook</u> from the Bureau of Labor Statistics, all "Athletic trainers need at least a bachelor's degree" (BLS). Anyone doing this job needs to be able to help someone with a bodily dysfunction. So, in order to be informed properly, people

The athletic trainer must know what they are doing for every injured athlete. If they do not know the material, for this job very well, then they are going to be fired quickly for harming someone critically. The material that people learn from specific classes pertaining to therapy can also be used in becoming a nurse, possibly a paramedic, or even a first aid instructor. Because of the education that trainers have received, they will not have to look far for a job that they like, even if that career is not specifically an athletic trainer.

The Occupational Outlook Handbook from the Bureau of Labor Statistics states, "Nearly all states require athletic trainers to be licensed or certified; requirements vary by state" (BLS): Those who are in this field of work show that their talents are highly skilled. It also shows the athlete or person that is being treated that they [athletic trainers] have been certified by an association in that specific line of work. In order to be licensed or certified as an athletic trainer, they must know the following: anatomy, first aid, and social skills, to name a few. Some of the best colleges are University of Florida, Boston University, University of Michigan, University of Texas at Austin, and the University of Illinois at Urbana Champaign. These colleges are the best for people who are wanting to go into this job because these college's main studies are specific to an athletic trainer (Fucci).

Within our government's statistical data, "Athletic trainers may spend their time working outdoors on sports fields in all types of weather" (BLS): This shows that people who take this job must be adaptable in any type of weather or environment. When athletic trainers go to any type of sporting event, they are not guaranteed what the weather will be unless its an indoor event. So, they must be prepared for any type of weather, prepared to do procedures that are necessary if someone hurts himself/herself and also prepared to focus on what is best for the

This job requires one to have other responsibilities, like caring for recently injured players. Officially some other jobs could pay better than an athletic trainer, like a doctor or a physical therapist, but this job also gives people more experience in other types of jobs because of the education. In conclusion, the requirements needed to become a successful athletic trainer are a positive attitude and good communication skills.
