## **SUBJECT:** Strategies to Support English Learner (EL) Newcomer Students and Students with Limited or Interrupted Formal Education (SLIFE) Training of Trainers (TOT)

As part of the Virginia Department of Education's ongoing effort to support school division personnel in planning and implementing evidence-based instructional strategies and programs for English Learners (ELs), a one-day training titled *Strategies to Support EL Newcomer Students and SLIFE TOT* will be hosted by Fairfax County Public Schools staff as specified below:
