SUBJECT: December 1 Child Count - Report of Children with Disabilities Receiving

Special Education

In order to comply with the information and reporting requirements of Part B of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA 2004), school divisions are required to make an unduplicated count of students with disabilities receiving special education services on December 1 of each year. A properly developed Individualized Education Program (IEP) or an Individual Services Plan (ISP) must be implemented for each student with a disability reported to the Virginia Department of Education (VDOE). This data should reflect students' records as of December 1, 2022.

The December 1 Child Count window will be open and accessible through the <u>Single Sign-on</u> <u>for Web Systems</u> (SSWS) portal on <u>Thursday</u>, <u>December 1</u>, <u>2022</u> - <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>December 14</u>, <u>2022</u>, for electronic data submission and subsequent submission to the division superintendent for approval/verification. Divisions are also responsible for completing the Parentally Placed Private School & Homeschooled Survey within the December 1 Child Count application. The survey must be completed prior to beginning the Child Count's approval process.

The division superintendent must electronically verify the data through the Superintendent Data Collection Approval (SDCA) application by **Wednesday**, **December 14**, **2022**. Submissions

made after the child count window officially closes for the collection year may impact the division's local determination rubric for inaccurate or untimely data submission.

Data collected through the December 1 Child Count forms the basis for state funding and federal reporting; therefore, the information submitted is subject to audit by the United States Department of Education, the VDOE, and the Auditor of Public Accounts. Divisions need to maintain student records and conduct extensive verification and validation checks to ensure that data reported to VDOE are accurate.
