The <u>Virginia Literacy Act</u> (VLA), passed by the Virginia Legislature in 2022, seeks to improve K-3 literacy outcomes for all students in the Commonwealth. As part of this legislation, all reading specialists are required to receive training in evidence-based literacy instruction and science-based reading research.

The Department of Education and Virginia Literacy Partnerships will host a webinar on **March 29, 2023 from 12:00 – 1:00 pm** to review information about the training and the role of reading specialists. The webinar will be recorded and posted on the Department of Education website.
