**SUBJECT: 2017-2018 Student Record Collection** 

To comply with the information and reporting requirements for report cards and performance indicators of the *Every Student Succeeds Act* (ESSA), the Department of Education will be conducting the Student Record Collection for the 2017-2018 school year.

Beginning with the 2017-2018 school year, the Student Record Collection (SRC) will implement the following changes:

- Three new data elements in order to comply with the Regulations Governing the Collection and Reporting of Truancy Related Data and Student Attendance Policy
  - o Attendance Plan Code
  - o Attendance Conference Code
  - o Court referral/Complaint or Proceedings Filed Code
- Unexcused Absences will be collected during Fall, Spring and EOY SRC
- Days in Session will now be collected on the Fall SRC. This can be found under the Miscellaneous section
- The Truancy Conference data element has been retired.

There are several webinars scheduled to review the changes for the upcoming 2017-2018 Student Record Collection. The following sessions have been scheduled:
