Virginia Community College System (VCCS)

Director of Academic Programs and Policy

Dr. Lewis reported on status of EducateVA/Career Switcher program. The EducateVA Career Switcher program has 61 candidates enrolled in the spring cohort. These students will complete their licensure requirements on May 20. The spring ESOL New Teacher Academy wraps up on Thursday, February 9. These teachers have focused on strategies to support ELLs in the areas of speaking, listening, writing, and reading. On March 4, the ESOL PRAXIS Prep Workshop will begin in Woodbridge to help current teachers prepare for the PRAXIS Subject Assessment. Finally, 78 first-year teachers are being

Dr. Johnson reported that in January 2023, the VDOLI approved the VDOE Registered Apprenticeship program. The first round of implementation grants will begin this Spring.

Dr. Johnson also reviewed actions by the Board of Education since the last ABTEL meeting. Ms. Anne Holton gave additional information on these actions as well as other items before the Board, including the alternate pathway to licensure proposed by the Montessori Public School in Arlington.

Ms. Maggie Clemmons gave a legislative update on bills before the General Assembly relating to education.

Standing Committee Assessment Report

Dr. Johnson reported the ongoing concern regarding overlap & duplication of assessments, especially regarding the VCLA requirement. The staff will pursue additional information from the Pearson representatives regarding assessment accommodations and options aligned with the current VCLA skill assessment.
