SUBJECT: Use of IDEA Part B Funds for Coordinated Early Intervening Services

(CEIS) Survey

The *Code of Federal Regulations* (34 CFR §300.226 (d)) requires each local educational agency (LEA) that implements Coordinated Early Intervening Services (CEIS) to report to the state on the number of children who received CEIS and the number of those children who subsequently received special education and related services under Part B of the *Individuals with Disabilities Education Act* (IDEA) during the preceding two-year period. States and LEAs must maintain these records for audit and monitoring purposes.

The *Use of IDEA Part B Funds for Coordinated Early Intervening Services Survey* will be open and accessible through the <u>Single Sign-on for Web Systems</u> (SSWS) portal on Monday, May 15, 2023. Each school division must electronically verify the data through the Superintendent Data Collection Approval (SDCA) and complete this survey by **July 31, 2023**.
