SUBJECT: Grant for Tuition Scholarships for Licensed High School Teachers to be

Considered Faculty to Teach Dual Enrollment Courses

The Virginia Department of Education (VDOE) is seeking grant applications to provide tuition scholarships for licensed public high school teachers pursuing additional credentialing required to be considered faculty who are qualified to teach dual enrollment courses in high schools in their local school division.

Completed grant applications must be received by the VDOE no later than 4 p.m. on September 15, 2023, for coursework taken during the Fall 2023 semester. Applications must be received no later than 4 p.m. on February 2, 2024, for coursework taken during the Spring 2024 semester.

The General Assembly appropriated \$250,000 in fiscal year 2024 for tuition scholarships. Details of the grant opportunity and the process to apply may be found in the attachment.
