SUBJECT: The ACT WorkKeys National Career Readiness Certificate®

The National Career Readiness Certificate (NCRC) assessment may satisfy the industry credentialing graduation requirement for students who are pursuing the Standard Diploma as well as serving as a Standards of Learning substitute test for a verified credit in reading as described in Superintendent's Memorandum #038-16. However, it should be noted that the NCRC assessment consists of three subtests: *Applied Mathematics, Locating Information, and Reading for Information*.

Based on the <u>Board of Education's action</u> on February 25, 2016, students who achieve a score of "4" or higher on the *Reading for Information* test could use this score to earn a verified credit in reading. If the students also achieve a score of "3" or higher on the *Applied Mathematics* and *Locating Information* subtests, they would also earn the NCRC, and therefore meeting the industry credentialing graduation requirement.
