SUBJECT: 2016-2017 Student Record Collection

To comply with the information and reporting requirements for report cards and performance indicators of the *Every Student Succeeds Act* (ESSA), the Department of Education will be conducting the Student Record Collection for the 2016-2017 school year.

Beginning with the 2016-2017 school year, the Student Record Collection (SRC) will implement the following changes:

- A new data element to identify Foster Care Students has been added to satisfy the requirements of ESSA.
- The Military Connected data element definition has been updated to align with the federal definition.
- The codes for PK Experience and PK Funding Source have been updated.
- The Unexcused Absences data element definition has been updated.
- The Truancy Conference data element definition has been updated.

There are several webinars scheduled to review the changes for the upcoming 2016-2017 Student Record Collection. The following sessions have been scheduled:
