As you are aware, the <u>House Bill 585 Work Group</u> has been meeting throughout this year under a charge from the General Assembly to recommend changes to the statewide summative assessments and develop a plan for implementation of the revised assessments.

The Work Group included leaders from across Virginia and experts in assessment, including two superintendents who ensured that school divisions' perspectives were considered in the group's deliberations.

The Work Group's recommendations focused on five opportunities for the Commonwealth to strengthen its assessment system, including:

- clearer and more rigorous Standards of Learning
- more rigorous assessment items
- more timely, clear, and actionable reporting
- improved system coherence to ensure measurement of proficiency and student growth
- innovative assessment design and plan for future innovation
