SUBJECT: Announcing Counseling for Careers: The New Paradigm Workshop

The Virginia Department of Education (VDOE), in partnership with the Southern Regional Education Board (SREB), is offering a workshop for school counselors and career and technical education (CTE) instructional supervisors. The "Counseling for Careers: The New Paradigm" workshop will assist teams in examining comprehensive career development practices including:

- Academic and career planning; and
- Aligning school practices with standards and student career goals.

School divisions may send a team up to four, consisting of a division-level school counseling leader, high school counselor, middle school counselor, and a CTE instructional supervisor. The one-day workshop (9 a.m.-3:30 p.m.) will be offered in two locations as follows:
