The Board further delegated to the President of the Board and the Superintendent final negotiation of the college partnership laboratory school contract with JMU, including awarding start-up funds and up to \$11,344,000 in per-pupil funding from the College Partnership Laboratory School Fund in accordance with the Board's Guidelines and Criteria for the Award and Distribution of Lab School Start-Up and Per-Pupil Operating Funding Grants for Approved Lab Schools.
