CLASS Alignment Information for Early Childhood Mixed-Age Settings

All CLASS™ tools are based on the understanding that there are effective teacher-child interactions across age-levels. While specific examples may vary based on children's ages, there is also a great deal of similarity in the kinds of interactions that promote child learning and development.

The dimensions used in CLASS to define and measure effective teacher-child interactions are similar across the three early childhood age-level tools (infant, toddler, and preschool). This cross-age alignment allows for the use of Toddler CLASS in mixed-age settings, such as family day homes, that serve infants, toddlers, and preschoolers.

Infant and Toddler CLASS Alignment

- → Infant Relational Climate is similar to Toddler Positive Climate.
- → Teacher Sensitivity is included in both Infant and Toddler CLASS.
- → Infant Facilitated Exploration is similar to Toddler Facilitation of Learning and Development.
- → Infant Early Language Support is similar to Toddler Language Modeling.

Toddler and Pre-K CLASS Alignment

- → Toddler and Pre-K tools include several of the same dimensions; Positive Climate, Negative Climate, Teacher Sensitivity, Regard for Child/Student Perspectives, Quality of Feedback, and Language Modeling.
- → Toddler Behavior Guidance aligns with Pre-K Behavior Management.
- → The last indicator in Toddler Behavior Guidance aligns with Pre-K Productivity (minimal wandering and minimal waiting).
- → Toddler Facilitation of Learning and Development has indicators that align with Pre-K Instructional Learning Formats (active facilitation and children's active engagement) and with Pre-K Concept Development (expansion of cognition).
