## SUBJECT: Name Change for the Future Educators Association (FEA) Student Organization, Effective August 2015

Phi Delta Kappa (PDK) International, the parent organization of the Future Educators Association (FEA), is rebranding the student organization with a refocused mission and new name, *Educators Rising*. Educators Rising cultivates highly skilled educators by guiding aspiring teachers to become accomplished teachers, beginning in high school and extending through college and into the profession. Beginning with the 2015-2016 school year, Educators Rising will offer students and teachers significantly expanded resources:

- EdRising Virtual Campus an interactive community for students and teacher leaders to connect, share, and learn

- Video library of National Board Certified Teachers in action
- National leadership conferences and competitive events
- Micro-credentialing a competency-based virtual badging system to recognize students' mastery of skills
- Partnerships with postsecondary institutions
