## SUBJECT: Technical Edit to the 2008 Virginia *History and Social Science Standards of Learning* Curriculum Framework for Civics and Economics

The purpose of this memorandum is to notify school divisions regarding a technical edit to the 2008 *History and Social Science Standards of Learning* Curriculum Framework, which was adopted by the Virginia Board of Education January 2010. An edit was made in the Civics and Economics framework based on the 2013 legislation HB 2341.

In the Civics and Economics Curriculum Framework, the information for voter registration has been updated to reflect the change in the *Code of Virginia*. "Register online" has been added to the list of methods that citizens may use to register to vote in Virginia.
