SUBJECT: Rural and Low-Income School Program Symposium

The Department of Education is pleased to announce the Eighth Annual Title VI, Part B, Subpart 2, Rural and Low-Income School Program Symposium in collaboration with the Title III, Part A, Limited English Proficient (LEP) Program, and the Title I, Part C, Education of Migratory Children Program. This symposium is designed for practitioners and administrators employed in rural school divisions. *A Framework for Improving Reading in the Content Areas* will be presented by Dr. Margarita Calderon & Associates.

The focus areas are:

- 1. Selecting and teaching different types of key words, phrases, and frames;
- 2. Selecting reading strategies that make content comprehensible; and
- 3. Modeling how enhanced writing skills will meet Virginia's Standards of Learning.

This symposium will be held at **The Hotel Roanoke and Conference Center in Roanoke, Virginia, on March 18-20, 2013**. Registration will be held from 11 a.m. – 2 p.m. on Monday, March 18.
