## SUBJECT: Technical Assistance Academy for Coordinators of Title I, Part A; Title I, Part C; Title I, Part D; Title II, Part A; and Title III, Part A

The Virginia Department of Education is pleased to announce a two-day technical assistance Academy on **Tuesday**, **July 30 and Wednesday**, **July 31, 2013**, for division coordinators of the following programs:

- Title I, Part A: Improving the Academic Achievement of the Disadvantaged;
- Title I, Part C: Education of Migratory Children;
- Title I, Part D: Neglected, Delinquent, or At-risk;
- Title II, Part A: Teacher and Principal Training and Recruiting; and
- Title III, Part A: English Language Acquisition, Language Enhancement, and Academic Achievement.

The Academy will be held at the Hilton Richmond Hotel, 12042 West Broad Street, Richmond, Virginia. It will begin on Tuesday, July 30 with the opening session at 8:15 a.m., and it will end at 1:30 p.m. on Wednesday, July 31. Breakout sessions have been designed for new as well as experienced coordinators. Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis with space limited to 250 participants. A topical agenda is attached. A full agenda will be available on-site. Participants are asked to bring a laptop computer to access materials and presentations. The Office of Continuing and Professional Education at Virginia Tech will manage the registration.
