SUBJECT: 2013 Statewide Educational Technology Conferences

This fall several sessions will be offered by Virginia Department of Education staff at two statewide educational technology conferences, the Educational Technology Leadership Conference (ETLC) in November and the Virginia Society for Technology in Education (VSTE) conference in December. These sessions will provide updates to division technology leaders on various technology issues and initiatives.

The 19th annual ETLC will be held November 4–6 at the DoubleTree by Hilton Hotel in Williamsburg, and the overall theme is collaborative learning through technology. In keeping with the theme, ETLC organizers have arranged for the International Conference of Educational Innovation through Technology (EITT) to be held concurrently with the Educational Technology Leadership Conference. Also, once again this year, VSTE will be hosting an event on Sunday, December 8, for educational technology leaders, which is designed for division-level technology directors as they face the challenge of visioning, planning, and implementing educational technology.
