SUBJECT: Revised Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing

The Virginia Board of Nursing held a Program Director's Consultation Session on Friday, November 8, 2013, to review the revised <u>Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing</u>, 18 VAC 90-20-10 Statutory Authority: §§54.1-2400 and Chapter 30 of Title 54.1 of the *Code of Virginia*, revised November 21, 2013.
