This memorandum is a follow up to <u>Superintendent's Memo Number 313-17</u>, dated November 3, 2017. This communication provides school divisions with the training options for individuals seeking initial licensure or renewal of a license with an endorsement as a school counselor. Section <u>22.1-298.1</u>. of the *Code of Virginia* requires that "every person seeking initial licensure or renewal of a license with an endorsement as a school counselor shall complete training in the recognition of mental health disorder and behavioral distress, including depression, trauma, violence, youth suicide, and substance abuse."
