SUBJECT:	Save the Date for the 2022 Tornado Drill

The Statewide Tornado Drill, coordinated by the Virginia Department of Emergency Management (VDEM), is a yearly opportunity to prepare Virginians for tornado emergencies and to test public warning systems. Please mark your school calendar to note that Virginia's Severe Weather Awareness Week will be from March 7-11, 2022. The Statewide Tornado Drill will take place on Tuesday, March 8, 2022, at 9:45 a.m. (Backup date is March 10, 2022). The alert will go out via a Required Monthly Test (RMT) code from the National Weather Service to National Oceanographic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) weather radios and local broadcasters. Participation in the statewide drill fulfills the requirement of the Code of Virginia 22.1-137.1 for schools to participate in at least one tornado drill each year. Schools may choose an alternate date and time if this date is not convenient.

Since this year's drill will utilize the RMT, most NOAA weather radios will not automatically sound an alert tone. Those participating in the drill, including schools and businesses, should turn on their NOAA Weather Radio by 9:40 a.m. to listen to the voice broadcast. Local radio stations, television stations, and cable outlets will also broadcast the test message via the Emergency Alert System (EAS). For help with planning the drill, school officials may wish to contact their local city, county, or town emergency management office. Emergency management officials can assist school

personnel with identifying safe areas in the building and creating an emergency plan. A list of local emergency managers is available at the <u>Virginia Department of Emergency Management</u> (<u>VDEM</u>) website.
