SUBJECT: United States Department of Education Approval of Amendment 4 to

Virginia's Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015 (ESSA) State Plan

On March 3, 2021, the United States Department of Education (USED) approved Amendment 4 to *Virginia's Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015* (ESSA) State Plan. The approved amendment will result in the following changes to Virginia's ESSA State Plan.

- Modify plan to state that Grade 8 students who take rather than pass the Algebra I
   Standards of Learning assessment may use a higher-level math assessment for federal accountability in high school.
- Remove the Title I, Part C objectives from the plan to reference a webpage, thus
  allowing Virginia to modify these objectives during the typical review process without
  requiring a new amendment.
- Add an acceptable use of Title IV, Part A funds.
